Ballyholland Harps GAC Membership Options

- 1. Club Ballyholland Plus (£300pa / £25pm)
 - a. Family membership (2 x adults, all u-18 children, plus students/trainees)
 - b. Includes Camogie Club membership for family.
 - c. Includes a Down Clubs Draw ticket worth £120.
- 2. Club Ballyholland (£240pa / £20pm)
 - a. Family membership (2 x adults, all u-18 children, plus students/trainees)
 - b. Includes Camogie Club membership for family.
 - c. The minimum required membership level for adult football players.
- 3. Family Membership (£180pa / £15pm)
 - a. 1 x adult
 - b. All u-18 children (football only), plus students/trainees.
- 4. 1+1 Membership (£120pa / £10pm)
 - a. 1 x non-playing adult
 - b. 1 x u-18 (football only)
- 5. Juvenile Only Membership (£60pa / £5pm)
 - a. Available to primary school children only.
 - b. Does not include any form of adult membership
- 6. Social Membership Plus (£120pa)
 - a. 1 x non-playing adult only
 - b. Includes a Down Clubs Draw ticket.
- 7. Social Membership (£60pa)
 - a. 1 x non-playing adult only.

A few pointers / reminders:

 Only players still at primary school during the coming seasons can pay Juvenile Membership.

• Once a player begins a season in post-primary school, they must partake a membership scheme at a minimum of £10pm.

- Families (2 or more players) can pay £15pm family membership, but it should be stressed to parents that this does not include camogic registration fees.
- Club Ballyholland includes camogie registration for entire family, plus adult / student football registration, plus a lotto ticket, plus entry to Ballyholland senior matches for 2 co-habiting adults.
- "Club Ballyholland Plus" simply gets you a half-price Down Club Draws ticket.

When does Membership Elapse?

Membership is considered elapsed when either of the following happens:

- 1. An annual subscription is not renewed within 60 days of it expiring.
- 2. A standing order monthly subscription has not been received for 60 days.

Advisory re Camogie Membership

Ballyholland Harps GAC and Ballyholland Camogie Club are each separate clubs with their own constitutions and membership.

Obviously, there is a symbiotic relationship between the clubs, and one of the primary drivers in the creation of **Club Ballyholland** was to allow for integrated membership.

But, members of both clubs are advised that unless you are a Club Ballyholland then you only a member of the club(s) to which you directly pay membership fees.

Advisory re Membership and Ticketing / Voting

The membership options described above were streamlined then approved by our members at the 2019 AGM.

With paid-up membership (including the elapse period) clearly defined, the purpose of that motion was to provide our committee with a clear instruction for how the following mechanisms are employed:

- 1. The allocation of restricted, member-only tickets.
- 2. Who can vote at AGMs and EGMs.

What Is the Down Clubs Draw?

It is a monthly draw run by the Down County Board, where the majority of income s returned to clubs in line with the number of tickets of sold by that club

- Total prize fund: £110,000
- 12 monthly draws: with 5 prizes of £1,000 to be won per month
- 2 super draws (Aug and Dec): 1 prize of £5,000, 5 prizes of £2,000, and 5 prizes of £1,000
- Special club draw: every club guaranteed a £200 winner in our special club draw
- Special draw for fully paid up members: special draw for patrons who pay £120.00 in full before draw commences: 5 prizes of £200.00
